



CAMBODIA

Since 2005 Agape International Missions (AIM) has innovated on the ground in one of the most internationally notorious locations for child sex-trafficking -- Cambodia.

AIM is centered in Svay Pak, Cambodia and working to prevent trafficking as well as rescue, restore, and reintegrate men and women who are victims and the cause of human trafficking. Starting with a single restoration home for 20 rescued girls, AIM now has over 12 projects in multiple cities impacting over 10,000 people a year.

After years of ministry growth, AIM has expanded to multiple Rahab's House community centers, a Lord's Gym that reaches pimps and traffickers, AIM Employment Center (AEC) that gives young women a career in textiles, and a network of Cambodian Churches that are now educated about the issue they didn't even see back when AIM first started rescuing children.

WHY GO ON THIS TRIP?

This trip is unique because it brings to light issues and injustice we are surrounded with right outside of our doors. Cambodia is a country flooded with the injustice of human trafficking and AIM is taking action steps to prevent it. This trip is an opportunity to learn about what people around the world are doing to stop the similar injustice of trafficking that is right here in Nevada.

The Crossing firmly believes in providing opportunities for individuals to learn more about what God is doing around the world. We are committed to offering trips and service projects for you to see firsthand what ministry looks like in Cambodia and how you can actively contribute to serving others globally and locally. Our hope is that you will be compelled to change something within your lifestyle at home after this experience and make a greater impact in Las Vegas.

WHAT WILL WE BE DOING?

This team will begin the week learning in depth about Cambodian culture and history by visiting Tuol Sleng genocide museum and the Killing Fields. Then they will spend the weekdays at AIM partnering with missionaries at Rahab's house to lead devotionals and leadership/discipleship





training, teach in a week-long kids camp, do outreach in the brick factories, and eat lots of delicious Khmer food! This trip is highly relational and immersive.

WHAT ARE THE QUALIFICATIONS?

- o Must attend The Crossing or live in Las Vegas with the ability to attend team meetings.
- o Pre-mission trip experience is preferred, but not required.
- o Open to anyone 18+
- o Must have a passport 75 days prior to departure.
 - Passport CANNOT expire within 6 months of departure.

HOW MUCH WILL IT COST?

- \$2200 per traveler.
- What is included in the trip cost?

Airfare, housing, transportation, supplies, traveler's insurance and all meals while in Cambodia.

What is not included in the trip cost?

Passport, food while traveling to/from Cambodia, snacks/drinks at corner stores, and Souvenir shopping money.

Worried about raising funds?

God will provide! Your hard work is still required though, so during team meetings, your leader will discuss fundraising tips and ideas to help you be prepared for your journey.

LIVING/TRAVEL CONDITIONS?

Transportation: 12 passenger vans will be used for travel while in Cambodia.

Housing: The team will stay in a hotel (2 per room) in downtown Phnom Penh.
