WHO DO WE PARTNER WITH AND WHAT DO THEY DO?

We partner with Honoring the Father Ministries. By providing sports equipment and venues for competition, they have shared the Gospel with over 1,150,000 young men and women in Cuba, of which more than 165,000 have made the decision to make Jesus Christ their Savior.

WHY GO ON THIS TRIP?

Even as an isolated country with limited connectivity to the rest of the world, the Cuban church is growing at a phenomenal pace. This is a chance to encourage Pastors and leaders in their mission and help lay the groundwork for Cuba's eventual re-opening to the United States. When the floodgates do open, HTF wants to ensure those who grew up on the communist island have God as their foundation during the transition.

WHAT WILL WE BE DOING?

Much of the trip is listening from and encouraging Pastors from across the island. We'll be immersed in Cuban culture as we visit various small towns and house churches, providing financial support, and occasional leadership training. In addition, we will likely participate in a baseball game or two against a "local" team and then share the Gospel with those who we play against. Participants should be comfortable with sharing their testimony and small scale public speaking, scheduling ambiguity, 2-4 hour car rides, and have a general interest in sports.

LIVING/TRAVEL CONDITIONS IN CUBA?

Transportation: 7-10 passenger vans (pre-1980's models usually)

Housing: Bed and Breakfast style accommodations (With A/C and flush toilets)

Food: Home cooked local fare, such as chicken with red beans and rice, or roast pork and fried plantains.

HOW MUCH WILL IT COST?
