# ***What is expected of me ?***

**Be on time:** it's important that you are on time to rehearsals so that we are able to have the time we need to do line check and run through songs. If for any reason you are not able to be there at the expected time PLEASE communicate to the worship leader asap.

**Dress appropriately:** our goal when we are on stage is to point people to Christ and not ourselves. It is super important we are dressed modestly. We ask please No crop tops, skirts, dresses, inappropriate words or images, shorts that are below finger tip length, or clothing that is too revealing. If you are ever unsure if something is appropriate to wear you can always ask. :)

**Come prepared:** be sure to show up to rehearsal with the songs and your parts learned, your in ear monitor headphones, appropriate clothing, and a good attitude ready to have fun and worship God!

**Strive to reflect Christ on and off stage:** we want to try our very best to protect our role as worship leaders on stage when we are off stage. We never want to leave a poor impression of Jesus or our church on others. Being mindful of the way new live our lives is important as we lead people to the truth that worship is just music, it's our lifestyle.

**Communicate and respond:** Please have good communication with your worship leader. When it comes to availability, If you know in advanced that you will not able to serve for a certain time of the semester or year please communicate that to your worship leader ahead of time so they know how to work around that. Also, PLEASE respond to planning center requests right away, it affects the leader and whole team when requests are left not responded to since finding a team for each week is like a big puzzle. If you are unsure if you can be there that day yet just let the worship leader know asap so there can be a backup plan.
